Make it slow down! Hope everyone is having a good summer so far, but boy is it flying by!

Short and sweet this month.

Update on our dam improvement project is that there is no update! We submitted our revised plan months ago, but were informed that the NJDEP is understaffed and cannot give us a timeline on when the plans will be approved. Our plan was to hopefully start construction in the fall. I don't see it happening this year.

Reminder, we have been seeing a few beach parties at First Beach on the weekends, which is great that our members are enjoying and utilizing the properties, but many are not obtaining a permit prior. We now require a permit for parties of 7 or more non-member guests max. of 20(not including members). This is so we can ensure we have enough guards on duty and to avoid conflicts with multiple parties, clubhouse rentals and/or club events on the same day so we don't over burden the facilities. Please call the office at least a week (7 days) prior, first come first serve. If you fail to obtain a permit prior, you may jeopardize having your party on that day so please call to avoid any issues.

Quite a few members have still not picked up their badges as of yet. We don't mail them because of cost, but on occasion as a courtesy and at her discretion Lisa, our Office Manager, may deliver them. Remaining badges can be picked up at First Beach from Kristen our Beach Security/Lifeguard Supervisor from 11am-6pm each day.

Our last big event, our "Surf & Turf" Bash is scheduled for Saturday, September 2nd. It is always a huge success and a lot of fun each year; they have some new activities planned for the day.



It was reported that a swan was injured by a snapping turtle and brought to an avian wildlife refuge.

Mr. Wilsusen informed the Board of a donation made by friends of Al Gebhardt to fund a memorial bench in his honor. The Board decided to place the bench at Whites Cove.

The Social Committee reported about the recently held Pirate Day for kids at First Beach. Upcoming events include Karaoke on July 22nd, Community Drumming/Bonfire on July 28th, Ice Cream Socials, Kids Biathlon Friday, July 14th, and new Coffee and Crafts on Sunday mornings featuring Culture Cabin from Boonton.
